In view of this, the necessary precautions, reflected in the corresponding documents, have been adopted to guarantee the absence of incompatibilities that may violate the impartiality of personal acts.

This is coupled with a rigorous qualification process of the team of experts and the design of their continuing education In order to ensure the Policy of Independence, Impartiality and Integrity of **EUROAMERCA GROUP**, and without prejudice to the application of the corresponding regulations of GAFTA, FOSFA and SENASA or other specific provisions that provide for a broader regime in this area.

All people declare their possible conflicts of interest, so that they are evaluated by the entity, and acquire a commitment by signing two documents "Declaration of Independence, Impartiality and Confidentiality" and the "Declaration of Compatibility" It is prepared, implemented, maintained and reviewed a Procedures Manual, since in **EUROAMERCA GROUP** we do not only carry out inspections of ship loads, we also communicate and interact with people: our customers. Both the initial and periodic training are aimed not only at the training of personnel, but also provide the necessary knowledge about compliance with the requirements and awareness of the consequences that, in the organization and its personnel, may have the breach of these. The remuneration of the experts does not depend on the number of vessels or the results of the inspections, without undermining compliance with the parameters of quality and quantity established and quality of service. The possible conflicts of interest, the possible threats to the impartiality, are evaluated, eliminating or minimizing said threats. For all these reasons, **EUROAMERCA GROUP** ensures the impartiality, independence and integrity and technical competence of its actions, as an essential, permanent and priority objective, to enhance confidence in the results of its expert inspection in its environment of action. Analysis of Conflicts of Interest The manager annually, during the review by the management, carries out an analysis on the follow-up, the validity and convenience of the Conflict of Interest Policy.

Therefore, **EUROAMERCA GROUP** declares that:

Does not perform any of the activities prohibited by the General Accreditation Criteria (ISO / IEC 17020).

Both the company and its personnel are not part of another legal entity or Related Organizations that can affect EAG as an inspection body.

It is understood as a legal entity or Related Organization that has a relationship with the inspection entity by having some or all of its owners in common, common managers, contractual relationships, the same name, informal agreements or other reasons for which the related body has a interest in the decision on the inspection or have the ability to influence it and do not intervene in any activity incompatible with its independence of judgment and integrity with regard to its inspection activities.

There are no contractual commitments, or other means that may have the ability to influence the results of an inspection.

It is independent of the parties involved. Therefore, it complies with the regulatory requirements of application (ISO / IEC 17020) to be considered inspection body TYPE A.
